Careers



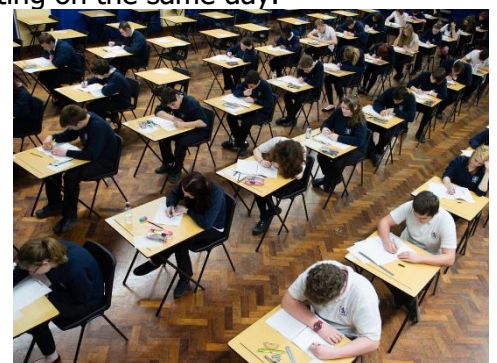
