Fundraising



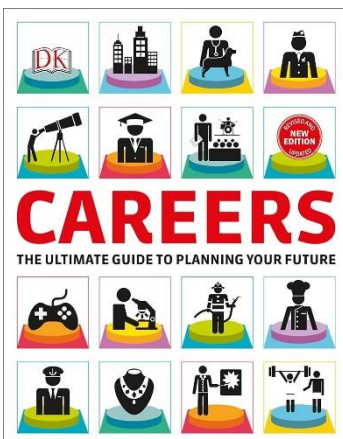
