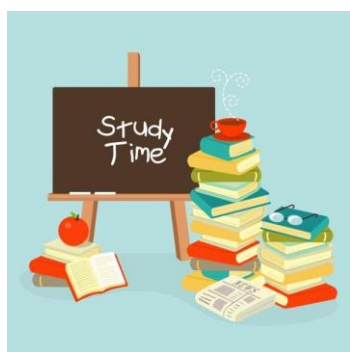


Year 13 Exam leave

A number of A level subjects will be running revision sessions during the May half term. The timetable, which Mr Whitehouse shared early in the week, is below:

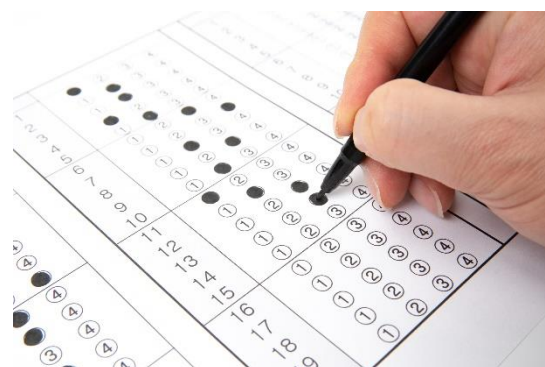
