Secondly, I wanted to outline the rest of the application process for you. All year 11 students should have received an email from 'sims' with details of how to sign up for Sims Student which is where students can apply. There are details of how to undertake this on the website as well. We have become aware that there have been a small number of issues with this, if your child is experiencing any issues please do contact myself or Mrs Panesar and we will be happy to support them with their application. The next steps of the process are detailed below:

- Application deadline 21<sup>st</sup> January
- Consultation appointments – February
- Offer letters will be received by the end of March at the latest.
- Sixth Form induction day – end of June (once GCSE exams are completed)

As you can see, once the application process has been completed the next big step is the consultation appointments. These appointments are put in place to make sure that all students are on the correct courses for their future plans. Students will be notified in plenty of time of the date of their consultation appointment.
