We are planning on having three events to celebrate the success of our year 13s:

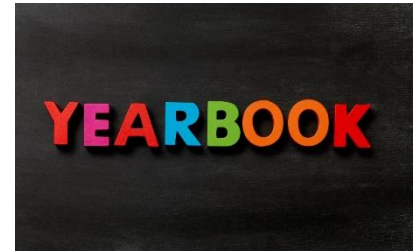
- Leaver's day will be held on 1st July. This will run from 10:30 until 1:30 in school.
